

## Musical Triplet

## Sympsonics Symbol

Three notes or tones sounded simultaneously as a **chord**. In the particular case above the **Musical Triplet** shows the notes C, E and G which may be expressed as a three part ratio: C : E : G or numerically 512 : 640 : 768. The actual frequency or rate of each tone or interval is entirely dependent on the scale used so the numbers per se are not the point of interest. Think in terms of relative ratio or relative quantity much as variable symbols are used in arithmetic; i.e., A + B = C where numeric values may be unknown but the relationship is known and maintained.

**Triplets**

A **triplet** is a group of **three** notes, or notes and rest that are played in the same time as **two** notes of the **same value**.

THEY CAN LOOK LIKE THIS...

Or

- If the notes of the triplet **are not beamed** ( $\text{♩}$  or  $\text{♩}$ ) then a bracket and a 3 is used to show that the three notes are in fact a triplet.
- If the notes of the triplet **are beamed** then the bracket is not needed, only the 3.
- If three of the same notes **do not have a 3**, then it is **not a triplet**.
