It is also known that **minute bubbles** of **carbon dioxide** (**carbonic acid gas**) appear in good **high-spring water**, if the **water** is exposed to the **influence** of **light** and **heat**. Its former full-bodied **wholesomeness** has therefore **vanished** without **trace**.
