2. It is also known that minute **bubbles** of carbon dioxide (carbonic acid gas) appear in good high-spring water, if the water is exposed to the influence of light and heat. If the water is again cooled under the exclusion of light, then the **bubbles** disappear. The crystal-clear water, however, tastes empty and insipid even when cool.
