Deva (देव in Devanagari script) is the Sanskrit word for [god](#) or deity. In modern [Hinduism](#), it can be loosely interpreted as any benevolent [supernatural](#) beings. The **devas** in [Hinduism](#), also called Suras, are often juxtaposed to the [Asuras](#), their half brothers. **Devas** are also the maintainers of the realms as ordained by the Trimurti. They are often warring with their equally powerful counterparts, the [Asuras](#). (wikipedia)
