Christ Returns - Speaks His Truth

"I was also shown the LAWS OF EXISTENCE controlling the human ability to create new circumstances and environment, relationships, achievement or failure, prosperity or poverty.

- Whatever man profoundly BELIEVES himself to be, good or bad, that will he become.
- Whatever man FEARS others will do to him, so will they do.

THE PARADOX OF FREE WILL

"As the Cosmic is not separate from its laws, so man is not separate from them. The Cosmic is not a personal Ruler way up in heaven; it is the "God of our hearts" which is within us just as we are within It.

Our Will - the true will of our soul, not every reflex urge of our body - is as free as the will of the whole, because our soul and Universal Soul are one. To the Mystic this oneness is not a theoretical argument but a real experience which brings great power and great responsibility:

Any creative thought which is clearly visualized and allowed to sink to the depth of man's soul, becomes a

thought of the Universal Soul and thus an established fact somewhere and sometime. Thus the freedom of the Mystic is a much greater privilege than is the individual freedom which seemed opposed to causality. It is not anarchy but free partnership with Cosmic Law." [Walter J.
