

nuclear center

Term used by [Russell](#) to denote the point in a [wave](#) of maximum opposition, [4++](#). Taken to be the same as [Keely's Neutral Center](#) and [center of focalization](#).

"Centripetal, closing spirals pack accumulating mass more closely together into vortices which are ever whirling toward the apices of ever shortening cones.

"The whirling vortices of closing spirals of opposing cones become **nuclear centers** of maximum [integration](#) and maximum resistance to integration."

"They [**nuclear centers**] are the [gravitative centers](#) of forming systems.

"They [**nuclear centers**] are the [focusing points](#) toward which all charging [light units](#) of increasing [potential](#), and integrating mass "fall," and become absorbed as heat units of potential energy; and away from which all discharging [light units](#) of lowering potential and disintegrating mass *rise* and are radiated as [heat](#) emanations."
