[9] **Bacteriophagous**: According to Collins English Dictionary a **bacteriophage** is 'a **virus** that is **parasitic** in a **bacterium** and multiplies within its **host**, which is destroyed when the new **viruses** are released.' Here the meaning of **bacteriophagous** has little to do with **bacteria** as such, but tries to express the notion of highly subtle, **autonomous entities** within entities endowed with the potential to impart **life-** or **death-** **decisive influences**. Viktor Schauburger also explains them as **threshold conformations** or **structures** which are neither **corpuscular**, nor **metaphysical** in nature. — Ed.
