noun: a word that has the same [meaning](#) as another word. For example “scared” is a **synonym** for “afraid.”

noun: two words that can be interchanged in a [context](#) are said to be **synonymous** relative to that [context](#)

What is a **SYNONYM**? When words divide **synonyms** unite. Words divide like a river but **synonyms**, as bridges, join opposite banks. Choosing words is like choosing one bank of a river over the other which includes one bank but excludes the other. Choose **synonyms**, the bridge, then have both sides.
