of twelve [mathematical scales](#) is that F# and G?, which in the [tempered system](#) are one, being counted the same, are made *two* scales in the mathematical; but it is a needless nicety. Twelve is the natural [number](#) and [period](#) for both mathematical and [tempered scales](#). And as the **system of twelve Fifths** contains the [key system](#) of music four times, only three of these twelve Fifths being required for any one [key](#), it follows that the [tempered key](#) is affected by only one-fourth part of the small amount to be tempered into the whole twelve.
